AHA Innovators' Network Member Noah Labs Secures Funding Round

We're excited to announce that Innovators' Network Member Noah Labs has successfully raised €3 million in equity and grant funding, led by Nina Capital, with support from adesso ventures, the DHZB Foundation, and notable business angels. The grant was awarded by the Investitionsbank des Landes Brandenburg (ILB) for Noah Labs' innovative research.

This investment accelerates the roll-out of Noah Labs Ark, an AI-powered platform for telemonitoring cardiovascular patients. Cleared as a class IIa medical device under MDR, it enables seamless remote monitoring of vital signs, helping doctors detect early deterioration and improve outcomes.

2024 Update: A Scientific Statement from the American Heart Association and the American Association of Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation

Since the 2007 update by the American Heart Association and American Association of Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation, there have been important advancements in cardiac rehab and preventing heart disease. New care options, like virtual and remote rehab services, have made these programs more accessible to patients. This updated guide focuses on key parts of cardiac rehab: patient assessments, nutrition, weight management, heart disease management, emotional support, exercise and physical activity counseling. It also highlights the need for programs to regularly check their effectiveness and improve where needed, helping to increase participation and reduce health disparities in access to cardiac rehab.
