

From Prototype to Impact: AHA's CarePlan Challenge Debuts at Scientific Sessions



Spotlight on Rising Innovator: Sami Farooqui

The Center for Health Technology and Innovation is proud to highlight the accomplishments of Sami Farooqui, a promising young scholar who embodies the spirit of innovation, scientific inquiry and service in health and medicine.

Sami recently completed an internship at the Cena Research Institute in Houston, Texas, under the mentorship of Asif Ali, MD, where he contributed to cutting-edge work in clinical research and cardiovascular innovation. His dedication culminated in the presentation of an Oral Abstract at the American Heart Association Scientific Sessions 2024 (AHA24) in Chicago. In addition to his research presentation, Sami showcased emerging ideas alongside established leaders in digital health and cardiovascular care in the Health Innovation Pavilion.

On May 10, Sami graduated from the University of Texas at Austin, where he earned distinction not only for academic excellence, but also for his service and leadership. He was selected as the student representative for the College of Natural Sciences and delivered an oral address at the UT Commencement ceremony, an honor reserved for exceptional graduates who exemplify the university's core values. Continuing his journey in medicine and innovation, Sami has been accepted to the Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, where he will begin medical school later this year.

HeartBeam and Innovators' Network member, AccurKardia, partner to speed up cardiac diagnosis

AccurKardia and HeartBeam are partnering to integrate AccurKardia's automated ECG analysis software into HeartBeam's portable, cable-free 12-lead ECG system. Designed to help physicians monitor cardiac health remotely, the system captures heart signals from multiple directions to assess conditions like arrhythmias. HeartBeam has submitted its ECG synthesis software for FDA clearance, while AccurKardia's platform enhances ECG interpretation by detecting both visible and hidden signals. Together, the companies aim to improve early and accurate heart health management.
